

FLASHBACK — NEW WALLMANS SHOW GALA PREMIERE 14th of September 2016

In 1886, the Circus Building opened its doors for the first time. Now, many years later, Wallmans are opening its famous doors for yet another season, but this time it is to celebrate the $130^{\rm th}$ birthday of the building.

Throughout history, the Circus Building has been known for housing all sorts of entertainment from allover the world. Wallmans are incredibly proud to be able to continue the legacy of the unique building and have for the last 12 years made Danish as well as international guests want to dance all the way home through the streets of Copenhagen after a magical night out.

The tremendous, four-hour show is seasoned with an exquisite 4-course menu served by Wallmans' artists and waiters.

The opening act of the year is a tribute to the Circus Building and its 130 years as well as the performers, who for more than 100 years have been working in the building – the circus artists.

But Flashback is also a musical journey which pays tribute to great stars like Bruno Mars, musicals like Fame and Dream Girls to a nostalgic 90's country medley with songs like "That Don't Impress Me Much", "How do I live" and "Life is a Highway".

Latin is hotter than ever with stars like Gloria Estefan, Ricky Martin and Jennifer Lopez, and the talented crew at Wallmans are letting their inner Latino loose to the pulsating rhythms of said artists.

Danish singer at Wallmans

The Danish singer Jean Michel Helgason, who became known nationwide in the Danish X-factor in 2012 and later performed in the musical Hair on Østre Gasværk and Hairspray in Tivoli, is the new Danish star of the year at Wallmans. With his fantastic charisma and brilliant voice, he will enchant the entire Circus Hall.

World-class artists

The Swedish world-star **Maryanne** has been leaving audiences spellbound for many years, and her extraordinary and dangerous acts has made her world-famous with performances in international TV-shows. With a combination of her sexy charm, humor and flair for fire and sharp objects she brings something to the table which has never ben seen before in the Wallmans Circus Building.

The Polish acrobats **Duo Creative** are with their superhuman strength and grace defying the laws of physics while they use their bodies to perform a beautiful and incredible hand-stand routine in the middle of the audience.

The Indian-born **David Hammarberg** (who, as the Swedish sounding name suggests, has been raised in Sweden) will be doing a swinging bungee trapez performance from underneath the ceiling of the 20 meter high dome which is guaranteed to take the breath away from the most experienced artist-enthusiast.

Something very special at Wallmans

A very important part of a night at Wallmans is when the person having his/her birthday is being celebrated, and this year, Wallmans are going all out in the name of love and romance and are converting the entire Circus Building into one big humorous wedding chapel with famous wedding songs from Bette Midler, Queen, Beyoncé and Joe Cocker.

All the songs of the show are in English, so foreign guests can enjoy the show and get the full experience as well.
