It is an award-winning act, which will have the whole audience holding their breath in a state of intense excitement. The performers in this enthralling act are Shannon Mcguire and Phillip Renaud.

Throughout the years Wallmans have presented a string of Danish singers on its stage, and this year audiences can look forward to meeting Louise Desiree Bottelet, to name but one.
